### Treatises of Watin and Mauclerc

Jean-Félix Watin's treatise has been published in more than one dozen editions and in several reprints and translations. *L'Art du peintre, doreur, vernisseur*, the main title, tends to remain constant in the French editions, although the subtitle varies and often indicates changes in content.
